In both 1989 and 1990, the six-cylinder 300E was judged among the best cars in the world by *Road & Track*.

Now, in advance of the 1992 model year, Mercedes-Benz previews the 322-hp 500E V-8 Sports Sedan—an automobile that extends 300 Class capabilities in virtually every area and shatters the very idea of the traditional sedan.

The 500 E is an inspired match of potential 5.0-liter engine and seasoned chassis. It is also a great deal more. The new, larger engine required that the front structure be substantially reengineered to preserve its offset-impact design. Intensive development of the front and rear suspensions produced enhanced handling and comfort. Even the underbody has been rearranged, to accommodate a larger catalytic converter beneath.



The 500E rides on new eight-hole 16-inch light-alloy wheels.



In appearance, the 500 E signals the most powerful Mercedes V-8 currently offered, with a lower stance, wider wheels and tires, sensuously swooping fender flares, and individual fog lamps integrated into the bumper. Inside, the 500 E has four fitted-leather bucket seats with generously extended lateral and thigh bolstering. Also, additional deepgrain walnut trim, a smaller, leatherwarapped steering wheel of distinctive design and a leather-clad shifter.

exquisitely smooth four-valve V-8. Two major advances: Fuel injection with hot-wire air-flow sensor, and a new torque-boosting tuned intake manifold. Vital statistics: 0-60 mph in 5.8 seconds, top test-track speed limited to 155 mph.

Among important dynamic systems, both ABS antilock braking and ASR auto-

matic slip control are standard. A special feature: automatic engine-torque reduction, to help reduce the effects of engine braking when decelerating or negotiating uneven surfaces.
